Through this program, we hope to support three teachers that would otherwise not have the funds to implement their ideas.

Who is eligible?

Certified teachers of grades pre-K – 12 in the Juniata, Perry, Cumberland and Dauphin County public, private or parochial elementary or high school.

How do I apply?

1. Complete an application.
2. Write a proposal that addresses the criteria listed below.

What information should be included in the proposal?

Written proposals should remain anonymous. School, student and faculty names and pictures are prohibited and will result in disqualification. *Please write a proposal that explains the following in detail:*

1. Brief description of project.
2. What is the projected long-term effect of this project on your students, school or district?
3. What are the project’s objectives?
4. State your project budget (estimate itemized costs).
5. Amount of funds requested (Maximum \$500.00).

Are there any restrictions?

Employees and officers of Pennian Bank and their families are not eligible. Proposals must be original.

When will winners be selected?

The money will be awarded once per year in November. Please allow up to four weeks for applications to be reviewed. Three checks will be issued in amounts up to \$500. If your proposal is selected for funding, we ask that you let us know the outcome of your project by submitting a brief description of its effectiveness and any pictures that were taken.
